## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act amending the charter of the town of Chelmsford relative to ministerial and grammatical non-substantive changes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 1-2 of the charter of the town of Chelmsford, which is on file in the
2	office of the archivist of the commonwealth as provided in section 12 of chapter 43B of the
3	General Laws, is hereby amended by striking out the words "Chelmsford Home Rule Charter"
4	and inserting in place thereof the following words:- "Chelmsford Home Rule Charter".
5	SECTION 2 Subsection (a) of section 2.5 of said shorter is hereby smonded by inserting

52 SECTION 20. Said charter is hereby amended by striking out sections 4-5 and 4-6 and 53 inserting in place thereof the following 2 sections:-

Section 4-5 Temporary Absence

55 The Town Manager shall provide annually to the Board of Selectmen a list of qualified 56 officers of the town and may designate by letter filed with the Board of Selectmen and Town 57 Clerk a qualified officer of the town from the list to perform the duties of the Town Manager 58 during a temporary absence or disability. If such temporary absence or disability shall exceed 59 fourteen days, any designation made by the Town Manager shall be subject to the approval of the 60 Board of Selectmen. In the event of failure of the town manager to make such designation or if 61 the person so designated is for any reason unable to serve, or is deemed not qualified by the 62 Board of Selectmen, the Board of Selectmen may designate some other qualified person from the 63 list to perform the duties of the Town Manager until the Town Manager shall return.

64 Section 4-6 Vacancy in Office

Any vacancy in the office of town manager shall be filled as soon as possible by the board of selectmen. Pending appointment of the town manager or the filling of any vacancy, the board of selectmen shall forthwith appoint some other qualified person to perform the duties of the town manager. The appointment of the acting town manager shall be for a term not to exceed six months, provided however, a renewal, not to exceed an additional six months may be provided.

  for a minimum of 1 year before becoming eligible to conduct any future audits.
  SECTION 26. Section 7-4 of said charter is hereby amended by adding the following

84 definition:-

(g) Officer: The word "officer" shall mean a position or board: (1) whose duties are
public in nature; (2) that has entrusted to it some portion of the sovereign authority of the state;
(3) whose duties are not merely clerical, but involve the exercise of power and authority
bestowed by the law; (4) that holds a position established by law.
