## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act Authorizing the Town of Hatfield to Continue the Employment of the Chief of Police.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Thomas J. Osley, chief
- 2 of the police department of the town of Hatfield, may continue to serve in such position until
- 3 June 30, 2017, or until the date of his retirement or until his non-reappointment, whichever
- 4 occurs first.
  
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
