## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Susan Tremblay, an employee of the Department of Corrections.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the Department  
2 of Corrections shall establish a sick leave bank for Susan Tremblay, an employee of the  
3 Department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more of his sick,  
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Susan Tremblay. Whenever Susan  
5 Tremblay terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave  
6 bank, the balance shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days  
7 shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the  
8 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
