The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)

An Act authorizing the town of Swansea to enter into a lease agreement for Medeiros Farm.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Board of
2 Selectmen of the Town of Swansea may lease, under such terms as it deems to be prudent, all or
3 portions of that certain parcel of land that is shown as Lot 17 on Swansea's Assessor's Map 27
4 and located at 1100 Bark Street, consisting of 22 acres more or less, for the purpose of
5 effectuation the creation and long term-maintenance of public ballfields thereon.

6 Section 2. This disposition of land is authorized in accordance with the provisions of
7 Article 97 of the Articles of Amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of
8 Massachusetts

9 Section 3. This Act shall take effect upon it's passage
