#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act establishing a select board in the town of Bolton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive
- 2 body of the town of Bolton, previously known as the board of selectmen, shall be known as the
- 3 select board and shall have the powers and authority of a board of selectmen under any general
- 4 or special law, bylaw of the town or rules and regulations applicable thereto.
- 5 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding chapters 40 and 40A of the General Laws, the attorney
- 6 general may approve amendments to the zoning by-law of the town of Bolton approved pursuant
- 7 to article 10 at the annual town meeting of the town of Bolton held on May 3, 2021.
- 8 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
