An Act relative to the elimination of an annual fee by veterans for distinctive license plates.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The fifteenth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “furnish”,  
3 in line 390, the following words:- “without charge”.

4           SECTION 2. Said paragraph of said section 2 of said chapter 90, as so appearing, is  
5 hereby further amended by striking out the third sentence.

6           SECTION 3. Said section 2 of said chapter 90, as so appearing is hereby further  
7 amended by adding the following paragraph.

8           Notwithstanding any provision of this section, no veteran, who is the owner of a private  
9 passenger motor vehicle or a motorcycle, shall be charged an annual fee for a distinctive  
10 registration plate.
