**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**

An Act designating a certain bridge in the city of Woburn as the Angelo Piazza Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The bridge numbered W-43-003 on Salem Street, crossing over MBTA railroad tracks,  
2 respectfully, in the city of Woburn shall be designated and known as the Angelo Piazza Bridge.  
3 The division of highways within the Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and  
4 maintain suitable markers bearing this designation in compliance with the standards of the  
5 department, which shall state, in addition to the designation, that “The Commonwealth  
6 recognizes the service of Mr. Piazza and gratefully dedicates this bridge in his honor, as a  
7 testament to his service to this country.”
