**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court

An Act establishing Massachusetts Learning Disability Screening Day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 15ZZZZZZ, the following section:-

3 Section 15AAAAAAA. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart
4 October 2 as Learning Disability Screening Day, to raise awareness of the necessity of screening
5 for reading disabilities and recommending that the day be observed in an appropriate manner by
6 the people.
