An Act directing the city of Boston Police Department to waive the maximum age requirement for police officers for Daniel Flores.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, including the  
2 provisions of Chapter 43 of the Acts of 2007, the City of Boston Police Department shall waive  
3 the maximum age requirement for original appointment of police officers for Daniel Flores. If  
4 Daniel Flores meets all other requirements set forth by the Boston Police Department, he shall be  
5 eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the position of police officer.

6           SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall take effect immediately upon passage.
