An Act relative to the compensation of the Soldiers' Memorial Commission of the city of Holyoke.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 113 of the acts of 1929, as appearing in chapter 44 of
2 the acts of 1979, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 8, the words “an unpaid commission”
3 and inserting in place thereof the following words:- a commission.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
