Soter and others for legislation to establish a medal of loyalty for the next of kin of certain service members who died in service while in the line of duty or who died as a result of wounds received in service while in the line of duty. Veterans and Federal Affairs.

### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act creating a medal of loyalty for families of veterans.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after section 67A the following section:-
- 3 Section 67B. There shall be a medal of loyalty, which shall be awarded to the next of kin
- 4 of service men and women from the commonwealth who died in service while in the line of duty
- 5 or who died as a result of wounds received in service while in the line of duty, but not
- 6 necessarily while in combat, in a war zone or as a result of action of an enemy. The adjutant
- 7 general and 2 field grade officers of the armed forces of the commonwealth detailed by the
- 8 commander-in-chief shall constitute a commission to make recommendations to the commander-
- 9 in-chief for the awarding of the medal of loyalty.
