An Act Exempting the Positions of Laborer, Skilled Laborer, Mechanic and Craftsman in the Town of North Andover from the Civil Service Law..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the positions of laborer,
- 2 skilled laborer, mechanic and craftsman in the town of North Andover shall be exempt from
- 3 chapter 31 of the General Laws.
  
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall not impair the civil service status of any person holding
- 5 the labor service position of laborer, skilled laborer, mechanic or craftsman in the town of North
- 6 Andover on the effective date of this act.
  
- 7 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
