By Mr. Cutler of Duxbury, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4346) of Josh S. Cutler (by vote of the town) that the town of Pembroke be authorized to issue bonds for certain municipal improvements. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the issuance of certain bonds by the town of Pembroke.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 7, clause (20) of chapter 44 of the
2	General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the town of Pembroke is
3	authorized to borrow the \$820,000 authorized for the construction of a sidewalk on Hobomock
4	Street from Learning Lane to Center Street in such town by the vote of the town passed under
5	Article 12 of the warrant for the May 10, 2016 annual town meeting pursuant to such clause (20)
6	for a term of 20 years, exclusive of the term of any temporary notes issued in anticipation thereof

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
