An Act relative to organ retention.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 13 of chapter 38 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence,
- 3 the following sentence:- If upon release of the body, any whole body part or organ of the
- 4 deceased has been retained by the office, the authorized person receiving the body shall be so
- 5 informed.
- 6 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of said section 13 of said chapter 38, as so appearing,
- 7 is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence, the following sentence:- No body part
- 8 or organ may be retained for purposes other than determining the cause of death without consent
- 9 from the deceased's next of kin.
