Pacheco (by vote of the town) for legislation to allocate the local option meal tax for the purchase of capital items. Revenue. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act designating certain tax revenue in the town of Wareham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. All sums received by the town of Wareham pursuant to section 2 of chapter 64L of
- 2 the General Laws shall be used for capital items, as defined by the Wareham town charter, and
- 3 shall be in addition to the town's annual budget for capital items.

- 4 The existing Wareham town charter and by-laws for bringing capital items before town meeting
- 5 shall remain in force.

- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
