An Act relative to amending the Middleton town charter.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 5 of the charter of the town of Middleton, which is on
2 file in the office of the archivist of the commonwealth as provided in section 12 of chapter 43B
3 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

4 5-4-2: Two (2) alternate members shall be appointed jointly by the Board of Selectman
5 and the Planning Board for one year terms.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
