Petruccelli for legislation to designate certain pavilions in the city of Revere as the Norman Gautreau memorial pavilions. State Administration and Regulatory Oversight.

An Act designating certain pavilions in the city of Revere as the Norman Gautreau Memorial Pavilion's .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A pavilion located on Revere Beach Boulevard and Revere Street in the City of
2 Revere shall be designated and known as the Norman Gautreau Memorial Pavilion in honor of
3 Revere artist Norman Gautreau. The department of conservation and recreation shall elect and
4 maintain suitable markers bearing said designation in compliance with the standards of the
5 department.

6 SECTION 2. A second pavilion located on Revere Beach Boulevard and Revere Street in the
7 city of Revere shall be designated and known as the Norman Gautreau Memorial Pavilion in
8 honor of Revere artist Norman Gautreau. The department of conservation and recreation shall
9 erect and maintain suitable markers bearing said designation in compliance with the standards of
10 the department
