## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Twelve

An Act Establishing a Sick Leave Bank for Mr. John Kelley, an Employee of the Department of Corrections..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 2 Department of Corrections shall establish a sick leave bank for John Kelley, an employee of the
- 3 Department of Corrections. Any employee of the Department of Corrections may contribute 1 or
- 4 more sick, personal, or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by John Kelley. Upon such
- 5 time as said John Kelley's termination of employment with said department or requests to
- 6 dissolve said sick leave bank, the balance of sick leave shall be transferred to the registry of
- 7 motor vehicles paid leave bank.
  
- 8 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
- 9 necessitates the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the registry of motor
- 10 vehicles.
