## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to regulation of hydrofluorocarbons substitutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 101. The state building code and specialized codes shall permit the use of any
- 3 refrigerant listed as an acceptable substitute or safe alternative by the United States
- 4 Environmental Protection Agency in the Significant New Alternatives Policy program,
- 5 established pursuant to section 612 of the federal Clean Air Act, as codified in 42 U.S.C. 7671k;
- 6 provided, that any equipment using said refrigerant, including but not limited to freezers,
- 7 refrigerators, refrigerator-freezers, and air conditioning equipment, shall be listed and installed in
- 8 compliance with the safety standards required by the United States Environmental Protection
- 9 Agency in said Significant New Alternatives Policy program established pursuant to said section
- 10 612 of the federal Clean Air Act, as codified in said 42 U.S.C. 7671k
