An Act to further the sharing of information by the Registry of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following section:-

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4 Section 62. Following any suspension or revocation pursuant to subsections (a) and (b) 5 of section 22, and sections 22F, 22I, 24, 24¹/₂, 24D, 24G and 24L, the registrar shall timely 6 notify the police department of the municipality in which the licensee or registrant resides 7 providing written notice of the name and address of the licensee or registrant, the license plate 8 number of any vehicle registered to the operator at the time of the suspension or revocation, and 9 the reasons for the suspension or revocation, accompanied by a copy of the operator's driving 10 record; provided, that the registrar shall timely notify said police department following any 11 reissuance of the license or registration. 12 SECTION 2. The registrar of motor vehicles shall submit a report to the joint committee

SECTION 2. The registrar of motor vehicles shall submit a report to the joint committee on transportation and the house and senate committees on ways and means on the implementation plan for section 62 of chapter 90 of the General Laws. The report shall include, but shall not be limited to, the technical capabilities of providing the necessary information to municipalities, the volume and rate of information that will be provided to municipalities and any possible complications or impediments with implementing said section 62. The report shall be submitted on or before June 1, 2015.

19 SECTION 3. Section 1 shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
