An Act authorizing the city of Chicopee to amend its city charter.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 239 of the acts of 1897 is hereby amended by striking out section  
2 49.

3 SECTION 2. Said chapter 239 is hereby further amended by striking out section 52 and  
4 inserting in place thereof the following section:-

5 Section 52. The conviction of an incumbent of any of the offices of the city government  
6 of a crime which results in imprisonment shall operate to create a vacancy in the office held by  
7 him.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
