# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act authorizing the town of Provincetown to provide an affordable housing donation checkoff box on town of Provincetown tax bills.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The town of Provincetown may, subject to the approval of the commissioner
- 2 of revenue, designate a place on its municipal tax bills, motor vehicle excise tax bills or mail
- 3 with such tax bills a separate form whereby taxpayers of the town may voluntarily check off,
- 4 donate or pledge an amount of money, which shall increase the amount already due and which
- 5 shall be paid over to the Provincetown Affordable Housing Trust Fund, established pursuant to
- 6 chapter 230 of the acts of 2002 for the support of the town's affordable housing efforts.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
