An Act relative to a cranberry water use transfer program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Executive
- 2 Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs shall provide authorization that cranberry water use
- 3 registrations and permits issued pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 21G can be used for mitigation by
- 4 other municipal permitted or registered users within the same watershed, provided that users
- 5 obtain the appropriate registrations and permits issued pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 21G for the
- 6 new water use.
