AN ACT PERMITTING NON PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS TO TAKE MCAS EXAM

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section II of Chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the 12th paragraph the following paragraph:—
