The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act relative to student data privacy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by adding at the end
2 thereof the following section:--

3 Section 95. For the purposes of this section the term “educational institution” shall mean
4 a primary or secondary school, a school district or a board of cooperative educational services.

5 Any person: (1) who provides account-based access to a website or an online service for an
6 educational institution; (2) who marketed and designed the online service for the educational
7 institution; and (3) who has knowledge that the online service collects data related to a student,
8 shall not use the online service to sell student data or to process student data in furtherance of
9 advertising; provided that the online service provider may process student data to provide,
10 improve, develop or maintain the integrity of its online services.
