**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act authorizing the city of Revere to grant up to two additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the city of Revere may grant two additional licenses for the sale of all
3 alcoholic beverages not to be drunk on the premises pursuant to section 15 of said chapter 138 to
4 businesses located and operating within the Suffolk Downs Overlay District in the city of
5 Revere. The license shall be subject to all other provisions of said chapter 138 except said
6 section 17.

7 (b) The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of a license granted under
8 subsection (a) to any other location, but it may grant a license to a new applicant at the same
9 location.

10 (c) If a licensee terminates or fails to renew a license granted under this section or any
11 such license is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it shall be returned physically, with all of
12 the legal rights, privileges, and restrictions pertaining thereto, to the licensing authority, which
13 may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same location under the same conditions as
14 specified in this section, otherwise such license shall dissolve.

15 (d) A license granted under this section shall be issued within one year after the effective
16 date of this act; provided, however, that a license originally granted within that time period may
17 be granted to a new applicant under subsections (b) and (c) thereafter.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
