### AN ACT RELATIVE TO SPECIAL EDUCATION ENROLLMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 70 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by striking the third and fourth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following paragraphs: -

3           “Assumed tuitioned-out special education enrollment”, the prior 5 year district average percentage of  
4 students included in foundation enrollments on Special Education Individual Education Plan whom the district has  
5 placed in out of district placements.

6           “Assumed in school special education enrollment”, the prior 5 year district average percentage of students included  
7 in foundation enrollments on Special Education Individual Education Plans who attend district schools.
