An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Brian Bailey, an employee of the department of developmental services.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of developmental services, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of  
2 developmental services shall establish a sick leave bank for Brian Bailey, an employee of the  
3 department of developmental services. Any employee of the department of developmental  
4 services may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave  
5 bank for use by Brian Bailey. If Brian Bailey terminates employment with the department of  
6 developmental services or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the  
7 sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall  
8 not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment  
9 of the sick leave bank as determined by the department of developmental services.
