The committee on Environment, Natural Resources and Agriculture, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 735) of David Biele for legislation to limit the number of special use permits that the Department of Conservation and Recreation may issue requiring the closure of all or a portion of Columbia Road or Day Boulevard, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 740) of Tackey Chan for legislation to require the dredging of the harbor area surrounding Houghs Neck in the city of Quincy, the joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 819) of James M. Kelcourse and Diana DiZoglio that the city of Newburyport and the Department of Conservation and Recreation be authorized to enter into an agreement for the joint collection of surcharges for motor vehicles parking in certain state owned parking facilities, the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 863) of Angelo M. Scaccia and David Hodgdon that the Department of Conservation and Recreation be directed to perform regular review and maintenance of the Neponset River in the city of Boston, and the joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4004) of Edward F. Coppinger and Michael F. Rush relative to certain property to be used for conservation or recreational purposes in the West Roxbury neighborhood of the city of Boston, reports the accompanying order (House, No. 5070) ought to be adopted.
