Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

3 Section 54C. The department of elementary and secondary education upon request shall
4 assist a school district in the development of a program to identify and serve pupils with light-
5 based reading difficulties, such as scotopic sensitivity.
