Cutler relative to the minimum amount of school aid available to municipalities; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 631) of Bradley H. Jones, Jr., and others for legislation to permanently establish the Foundation Budget Review Commission; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 632) of Bradley H. Jones, Jr., and others relative to the establishment of an advisory board to promote the improved use of school-level data for effective resource allocation decisions at the local level; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 655) of Jay D. 1           *Ordered,* That the committee on Education be authorized to sit during a recess of the  
2 General Court to make an investigation and study of House documents numbered 537, 560, 562,  
3 631, 632, 655, 704 and 2187, relative to Education Matters related to school finance and  
4 governance matters.

5           Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study  
6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such  
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives  
8 on or before December 31, 2022.
