An Act to allow elected officers in the town of Lee to serve on the Board of Public Works.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Sean Regnier moved (second by Dave Consolati) that the Town vote to  
2 authorize the Board of Selectmen to petition the General Court to revoke so much of Chapter 438  
3 of the Acts of 1970 that prohibits elected officers in the Town of Lee from serving on the Board  
4 of Public Works, and specifically, removing the words "or any holder of an elected office in the  
5 Town of Lee" from said Act.

6           Motion PASSED after debate.
