## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act to increase access to information regarding drug overdose deaths  $\Box$ .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of Chapter 38 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking the first
- 2 paragraph and replacing it with the following:-
- 3 "If, during the course of investigation, the medical examiner is of the opinion that the death may
- 4 have been caused by the act or negligence of another, or by the ingestion of narcotics, he or she
- 5 shall at once notify the district attorney within whose district the deceased was found and the
- 6 local law enforcement agency for such district or, if such act or negligence has occurred in a
- 7 different district, the district attorney and the local law enforcement agency for such other

8	district. He or she shall also make available to the district attorney and the local law enforcement	
9	9 agency any and all records pertaining to such investigation."
