The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court (2025-2026)

An Act establishing comprehensive school counseling programs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting the following:-
- 3 "Each public school district shall develop and implement a comprehensive school
- 4 counseling program that adheres to the Massachusetts Model for Comprehensive School
- 5 Counseling Programs and ensures all pre-K to grade twelve (12) students will receive school
- 6 counseling services from licensed school counselors. In accordance with the Model, each school
- 7 counselor is to spend at least eighty percent (80%) of that school counselor's time providing
- 8 direct or indirect services to students. To maintain equity in student access to a school counselor,
- 9 each district shall provide one (1) school counselor for a maximum of two hundred fifty (250)
- students, the nationally recommended average."
