The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act ensuring election integrity through voter identification.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 76 of Chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence in its entirety and replacing
- 3 it with the following sentences:— "An election officer shall ask each voter desiring to vote at a
- 4 polling place for his full name and current residence address and repeat the full name and address
- 5 stated by the voter. The officer shall ask the voter to present any one of the following forms of
- 6 identification: his Commonwealth of Massachusetts voter registration card, his social security
- 7 card, his valid Massachusetts driver's license, or any other identification card issued by a
- 8 government agency by the Commonwealth, one of its political subdivisions, or the United States;
- 9 or any valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the voter and issued by an
- 10 employer of the voter in the ordinary course of the employer's business."

- SECTION 2. Section 76B of Chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 12 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the entire section and inserting the following
- 13 section in place thereof:—"Section 76B. Any person desiring to vote who fails to present
- 14 suitable identification shall not be permitted to vote."
