# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act relative to prescription opioid abuse prevention education.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 71 of the general laws, as so appearing in the 2018

2 edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "violence", in line 22, the following

3 words:- ", prescription opioid abuse prevention, with an emphasis on the prescription drug

4 epidemic and the connection between prescription opioid abuse and addiction to other drugs,

5 such as heroin,".
