AN ACT ELIMINATING POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE CONTRIBUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by striking section 6A and inserting in place thereof the following section:-
- 3 “Section 6A. A candidate and such candidate’s committee shall not accept any contributions
- 4 from a political action committee.”
