An Act relative to cancellation devices on voting machines.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 33 of chapter 54 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out in the second sentence, the words “registering and cancelling” and  
3 inserting in place thereof the following words: and registering.

4 SECTION 2: This act shall take effect upon passage.
