An Act relative to political contributions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1:	Section 7	a of the l	Massachusetts	General	Laws Cha	pter 55 in	hereby

2 amended by striking out the language in subsection (3) and replacing it with the following;

- 3 (3) An individual may in addition make campaign contributions to any political
- 4 committee not specified in paragraph (1), (2), (4) or (5); provided, however, that the aggregate of
- 5 such campaign contributions to any one such political committee shall not exceed in any one
- 6 calendar year the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500).
- 7 SECTION 2: Section 7a of the Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 55 in hereby
- 8 amended by adding the following subsection;

9 (5) An individual may in addition make campaign contributions to any independent 10 expenditure PAC as defined in section 18A; provided, however, that the aggregate of campaign 11 contributions to any one such independent expenditure PAC shall not exceed in any one calendar 12 year the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000).
