Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 21K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended by replacing \$3,000 to \$5,000 in paragraph m line 3
