### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act expanding the definition of affordable housing to include manufactured homes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 40B of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 20 the following section:
- 3 Section 20A. All manufactured homes, as defined in section 32Q of chapter 140, in a
- 4 manufactured housing community, as defined in section 32F of chapter 140, located within a city
- 5 or town shall be included as low or moderate income housing for the purposes of sections 20 to
- 6 23, inclusive, toward a city or town's count of housing units.
