By Mr. Markey of Dartmouth, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 661) of Christopher M. Markey relative to the disclosure of information concerning public school post-regular season athletic events. Education.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to the disclosure of information of public school athletic resources and interscholastic athletic authorized representatives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Authorized representatives of school committees active in the selection,
2 organization, payment, licensing, franchising and arranging of post-regular season interscholastic
3 competitions or events, including, but not limited to, the Massachusetts Interscholastic Athletic
4 Association, shall annually report to its member districts the costs, expenses, contracts, salaries,
5 honorarium, gratuities, revenue and all other financial matters regarding post-regular season
6 interscholastic competitions or events.

7 Said annual report shall include:

8 1. an accounting of revenue including member district dues and private donations
9 collected;

10 2. an accounting of gate receipts and concession revenues collected at post-regular season
11 interscholastic competitions or events;

- 12 3. a schedule of costs attributable to procuring all sites for post-regular season
13 interscholastic competition;
- 14 4. a schedule of expenses, including itemized salaries, itemized honorarium, itemized
15 travel expenses, itemized meal expenses, costs of securing a venue, security costs and all
16 expenses that are paid or incurred but unpaid in the organization of post-regular season
17 interscholastic competition;
- 18 5. a schedule of expenses including itemized salaries, retirement plans or any expenses of
19 authorized representatives of school committees who are active in selecting, organizing, paying,
20 licensing, franchising and arranging post-regular season interscholastic competitions or events,
21 including, but not limited to, the Massachusetts Interscholastic Athletic Association;
- 22 6. the criteria for site selection of a post-regular season interscholastic competition;
- 23 7. a written review of the site selection process; and
- 24 8. the final evaluation and scoring that determined the selection of the sites chosen for
25 any post-regular season interscholastic competition.

26 The report shall also include an evaluation of all athletic facilities that are available for
27 post-regular season interscholastic competition. This evaluation shall begin at the end of each
28 school year, on or before June 30, and shall incorporate all available data related to post-regular
29 season interscholastic competition. This evaluation and report shall be updated annually and
30 shall be distributed to each school committee within 60 days of its completion, or before the first
31 Monday of December, whichever is earlier.
