## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act to authorize the city of Gardner to negotiate and purchase group insurance policies for employees and dependents without being subject to collective bargaining.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1

2 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 32B and chapter 150E of the General Laws or any  
3 other general or special law to the contrary, the City of Gardner is authorized to negotiate and  
4 purchase group insurance policies for Employees, Retirees and Dependents without being subject  
5 to collective bargaining as defined in chapter 150E of the general laws.
