Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of Chapter 4 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end of subsection Eighteenth B in the definition of
- 3 “Legislative Body,” the following sentence:- The legislative body for retirement boards shall be
- 4 the retirement board itself for those matters over which it has independent control.
