The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to inactive voters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 59 of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- A voter who appears on the inactive voters list shall be permitted to vote without making
- 5 written affirmation, signed under penalties of perjury, of the voter's current and continuous
- 6 residence in the municipality or, at a state primary or state election, residence in the municipality
- 7 within the previous six months, if the voter is able to provide suitable identification to the
- 8 presiding officer showing the voter's name and address as listed on the inactive voters list.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
