An Act relative to specially qualified voters.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 50 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 official edition, is amended by striking in the definition of “specially qualified voter.” All of  
3 subsection (ii) and changing subsection (iii) to subsection (ii).
