**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**

An Act ensuring accurate voter rolls.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 9 of Chapter 46 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 official edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting the following language at the end thereof:

3 “Upon pronouncement of death, a copy of the completed certificate of death shall be  
4 transmitted to the clerk’s office of the municipality where the deceased resided. Within 72 hours  
5 of receipt of the certificate of death, the clerk shall remove the deceased from the voter rolls.”
