## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act protecting the rights of assisted living residents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

### 1 SECTION 1: Section 14 of chapter 19D of the general laws is hereby amended by

2 adding after the words, "sponsor's covenant to comply with applicable federal and state laws",

3 the following:-

4 "including chapters 186 and 239 of the general laws"

5 SECTION 2: Section 14 of chapter 19D is hereby further amended by inserting at the

6 end thereof the following:-

- 7 "The Attorney General shall promulgate regulations pursuant to section 2(c) of chapter
- 8 93A of the general laws to protect the consumer rights of residents of assisted living residences,
- 9 including all assisted living residences operated by facilities providing continuing care as defined
- 10 by section 76 of chapter 93, against unfair deceptive acts or practices and to provide that the

- violation of such regulations as well as the regulations pursuant to chapter 19 shall be considered
  a violation of said chapter 93A of the general laws."
- 13 SECTION 3: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the attorney
- 14 general shall promulgate regulations pursuant to Section 2 of this act, no later than one year
- 15 following the passage of this act.
