An Act to amend retirement benefits for certain employees of the department of corrections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Group 4 paragraph (g) of sub-division 2 of section 3 of Chapter 32, as amended by
2 section (1) of Chapter 71 of the acts of 2006, is hereby further amended, by inserting after the
3 words “supervising prison camp officer,” the following words:— “correctional program officer I,
4 II, III.”
