Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as inserted by
- 2 section 80 of Chapter 127 of the Acts of 1999, is hereby amended by striking from paragraph (2)
- 3 the words:
- 4 - B, who is 65 years of age or older,
- 5 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall apply to all taxable years beginning on or after
- 6 January 1, 2013.
